



Latest Anti-Epidemic Arrangement (Circular No.: E133/2022-2023)

Dear Parents/Guardians,

With reference to the announcement “Health Advice to Schools for the Prevention of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)” released by the EDB on 28th February, the latest anti-epidemic arrangement for schools has the following update:

Primary Schools, Kindergartens, and Special Schools:

- The requirement for students of primary, Kindergartens and special schools to undergo daily RAT before going to school will be maintained until **15th March, 2023**.
- Students should continue to take body temperature before school every day. Parents should continue fill in and sign the health declaration form every school day.
- The mask-wearing requirement was lifted by the government on 1st March, 2023. Mask-wearing is not required for school teaching staff, students or school visitors. Parents may decide according to individual needs, if mask-wearing is necessary for your child.
- For the arrangements thereafter, EDB will review the situation and make timely announcement.

Arrangement for COVID-19 positive cases

If students are tested positive for COVID-19, parents must inform the school nurse. Students tested positive must take sick leave and **are not allowed to attend class at school** until a negative RAT result is obtained and students show no COVID-19 symptoms.
